2024 Global Education and Innovation Summit

-Over 200 participants, including education ministers, teachers, experts, and representatives of international organizations, will gather for the summit.

-Under the theme of "The Classroom Revolution Led by Teachers with AI", the summit will discuss digital education innovation.

The Ministry of Education (led by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education Lee Ju-ho), together with TV CHOSUN (led by Chairman Hong Doo-pyo), will host the *2024 Global Education and Innovation Summit* from August 28 (Wednesday) to 29 (Thursday) at The Shilla Seoul.

The Global Education and Innovation Summit is a platform where global education leaders, including education ministers and vice ministers, education experts, and representatives of international organizations, gather to explore the direction of education innovation in response to the challenges facing the world in the era of digital transformation and communicate to find answers through international cooperation. Speakers at the Summit will include the Minister of Education of Saudi Arabia, the Minister of Science and Higher Education of Kazakhstan, the Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Minister for Early Education in the United Kingdom, the World Bank's Global Director for Education, and former EI (Education International) President Susan Hopgood.

Under the theme of "The Classroom Revolution Led by Teachers with AI," the summit will consist of a keynote lecture, ministerial summit, teachers' summit, and expert summit to discuss digital education policies in each country, AI-based classroom innovation, and various issues in the process of digital education transformation.

In particular, the Summit will launch the Global Education and Innovation Alliance (GEIA), a partnership between the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Korea, the World Bank, the Ministry of Education of Saudi Arabia, the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of Kazakhstan, the Department for Education of the United Kingdom, and the Inter-American Development Bank. The Global Education and Innovation Alliance is a global collaborative system to achieve "Education for All" through digital education innovation, and will operate a network to share knowledge and experience among members and identify collaborative projects based on the core principles of digital-based education innovation.

At the summit, the AI Digital Textbook Experience Booth and the Next Classroom will be built and operated so that the participants can vividly experience the AI digital textbook prototype and the "Classroom Revolution Led by Teachers" initiative. In the Next Classroom, teachers leading the Classroom Revolution will demonstrate lessons using AI prototypes.

On Thursday, August 29, delegations and speakers, including the UK Minister for Early Education, who attended the Summit, will visit leading digital schools and AI platform companies. The site visits are expected to give delegates a more vivid experience of digital education in Korea.

In addition, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education Lee Ju-ho will hold bilateral meetings with ministers and vice ministers of major countries and key organizations participating in the summit.

In a bilateral meeting with the UK's Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State and Minister for Early Education, who visited Korea for the first time since the formation of the new cabinet in July, Deputy Prime Minister Lee Ju-Ho will introduce Korea's digital education innovation policy and discuss bilateral education cooperation in the fields of education technology (edtech) infrastructure and artificial intelligence (AI) between Korea and the UK.

In addition, the meeting with Saudi Arabia's Minister of Education, who is returning to Korea after his visit in May, will discuss specific bilateral cooperation issues such as AI and digital education cooperation and teacher training and capacity building between Korea and Saudi Arabia.

In his bilateral meeting with the Minister of Kazakhstan, the two ministers will discuss the exchange of higher education institutions and scholarship, and sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU) on cooperation in the field of higher education between Korea and Kazakhstan.

In addition, a working meeting with the World Bank's Global Director for Education will explore specific ways to cooperate with the World Bank, including digital-based education innovation and people-to-people exchanges in education.

"We look forward to continued communication and cooperation among major countries and organizations through the 2024 Global Education and Innovation Summit to discuss the direction of the digital transformation of education," said Lee Ju-Ho, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Education. "As a leading country in digital education innovation, Korea will continue to work together with the international community to realize the vision of 'Education for All'"
